APPLIANCES BIG AND SMALL: CLEAN, REPLACE OR SELL!

Only.	Group by how frequently an appliance is used: daily, several times a week, monthly, rarely or holidays
□ Don′	Within those groups, do you have appliances that can do double duty? Don't get rid of those. TIP: t buy appliances that have one use.
□ cupb	The items in your rarely used group: If the appliance was on the countertop rather than the back of a oard, would you use it more frequently?
☐ stora	Cords should be wrapped around appliance before storing. Small parts can be stored in labelled clear ge bags or clear plastic shoe boxes.
	Use a step stool to store appliances on higher shelves. I have my big turkey roaster on full display e my cabinets, among the bird houses, baskets and eramic urns.
