APPLIANCES BIG AND SMALL: CLEAN, REPLACE OR SELL!

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Group by how frequently an appliance is used: daily, several times a week, monthly, rarely or holidays only.

Within those groups, do you have appliances that can do double duty? Don't get rid of those. TIP: Don't buy appliances that have one use.

The items in your rarely used group: If the appliance was on the countertop rather than the back of a cupboard, would you use it more frequently?

Cords should be wrapped around appliance before storing. Small parts can be stored in labelled clear storage bags or clear plastic shoe boxes.

Use a step stool to store appliances on higher shelves. I have my big turkey roaster on full display above my cabinets, among the bird houses, baskets and big ceramic urns.

An organized kitchen enables easier meal preparation and clean up. We all need that!
