

Party Games for Christmas

Plate on the Head

Need sturdy paper (not styrofoam) plates and pens (not markers) for each player. All players hold the plate on their head with one hand and draw with the other hand following instructions called out by the host. Draw what is described without looking. No one looks at the plate until the host says the game is over.

- 1. Draw a line for a floor.
- 2. Draw a Christmas Tree. Add at least 4 decorations.
- 3. Draw a star on top of your tree.
- 4. Draw a fireplace with a mantel next to the tree.
- 5. Draw at least one stocking hanging from the mantel.
- 6. Draw one or more presents under the tree.

When finished, let everyone look at their plates. Players can then count up the points from their own plates or by swapping plates with someone.

- 2 points if the tree touches the floor.
- 2 points if your stocking is touching your mantel.
- 1 point if your star touches your tree.
- 1 point if your star is above your tree.
- 1 point for every Christmas ornament that is ON your tree.
- 1 point if your fireplace doesn't touch the tree (fire hazard).
- 1 point for drawing something decorative on your stocking.
- 2 points for each present UNDER your tree.

Player with the most points should get a really awesome prize!
