Clementine series by Sara Pennypacker     Lively, likable heroine for fans of Ramona and     Judy Moody.
• The Fudge books by Judy Blume Classic sibling comedy that still resonates today.
Graphic Novels & Popular Picks
Lunch Lady series by Jarrett J. Krosoczka     Action-packed graphic novels with a quirky twist.
Amulet series by Kazu Kibuishi     More advanced, great for kids moving into complex fantasy worlds.
